



TAP Small Grants

The Theoretical Astrophysics Program invites one-page proposals for small grants in support of theoretical astrophysics research at the University of Arizona. These \$500-\$1500 grants are intended to provide matching funds for equipment purchases, professional supplies, and support for conference travel for TAP members.

Proposals should provide evidence of high impact on the individual or a group research project, and identify matching funds. Proposals for equipment/supplies should provide realistic quotes and the programmatic reasons for and the impact of the specific items requested. Proposals for conference travel should include details of the conference, the applicant's role (e.g., invited/contributed presentation, talk/poster) and an explanation of the high impact.

TAP members from all three departments (*Physics, Astronomy, and Planetary Sciences*) are encouraged to apply.
